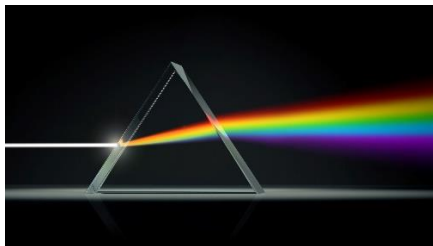
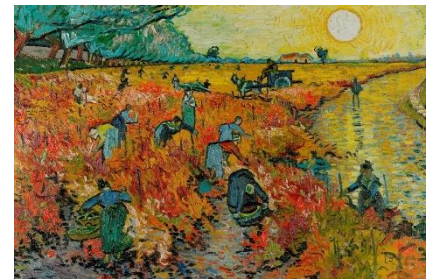
### Did you know?

### Did you know?

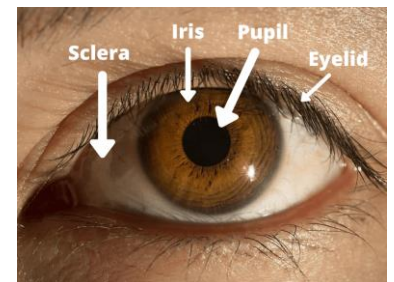

France is a country in Europe. It is bordered by both the Mediterranean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean.

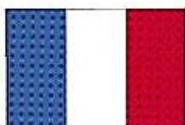
**LANDMARKS**

**FOOD**

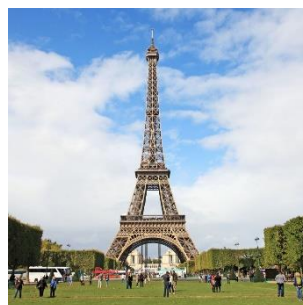
France is known for its food. French cooking is thought to be the best in the world. French dishes include Quiche, soufflés, mousse, pâté, croissants, crêpes, and French bread.
